

# 31 Sample Prayers for Children

Replace 'my child' with your child's name when you pray aloud.

[Day 1] 1 Samuel 1:26-28 (NIV)

<sup>26</sup> and she said to him, "Pardon me, my lord. As surely as you live, I am the woman who stood here beside you praying to the Lord. <sup>27</sup> I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of him. <sup>28</sup> So now I give him to the Lord. For his whole life he will be given over to the Lord." And he worshiped the Lord there.

Heavenly Father, thank you for giving me my child. I dedicate him/her to you. He/She will worship you as his/her Living God, now and forever. Amen.

# [Day 2] Luke 10:27 (NIV)

<sup>27</sup> He answered, "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind'; and, 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'"

Dear God, I pray for my child, to grow up loving you with his/her whole being and to love others as himself/herself. Amen.

#### [Day 3] *Proverbs 3:24 (NIV)*

<sup>24</sup> When you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet.

Gracious Lord, give the gift of sleep to my and myself every night, so we will be refreshed and rested every morning. Amen.

# [Day 4] Isaiah 54:13 (NIV)

<sup>13</sup> All your children will be taught by the Lord, and great will be their peace.

Grant to my child, dear Lord, a teachable spirit so that he/she will grow to maturity in Christ Jesus. Amen.

#### [Day 5] Isaiah 41:10 (NIV)

<sup>10</sup> So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Thank you, Almighty God, for protecting my child. You are always there with and for him/her. He/She will never be at a loss. Amen.

#### [Day 6] Acts 16:31 (NIV)

31 They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."

Dear Jesus, who is both Lord and Saviour, thank you in advance for the salvation of the child and family. Amen.



# [Day 7] Joshua 1:9 (NIV)

<sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

Lord Jesus, our Commander-in-Chief, I pray for my child to be strong and courageous as he/she follows after you. Amen.

# [Day 8] Hebrews 13:5 (NIV)

<sup>5</sup> Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

Givers of all good things, thank you for your provision. I pray for my child to experience contentment in your goodness. Amen.

# [Day 9] 1 Samuel 12:24 (NIV)

<sup>24</sup> But be sure to fear the Lord and serve him faithfully with all your heart; consider what great things he has done for you.

Thank you, Lord, for the great things you had done, is doing and will do in my child's life. May he/she grow up to fear and serve you faithfully. Amen.

# [Day 10] Galatians 5:22-23 (NIV)

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Holy Spirit, thank you for transforming my child from within resulting in godly character that glorifies Jesus Christ in his/her life. Amen.

#### [Day 11] Proverbs 13:20 (NIV)

<sup>20</sup> Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm.

Dear God, I pray that you will bring good and wise people into my child's life so he/she will be wise to acknowledge you as the source of his/her wisdom. Amen.

#### [Day 12] Philippians 2:3-4 (NIV)

<sup>3</sup> Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

Lord Jesus, grant to my child a humble and caring heart that pleases you. Amen.

#### [Day 13] *Proverbs 10:9 (NIV)*

<sup>9</sup> Whoever walks in integrity walks securely, but whoever takes crooked paths will be found out.

Father God, shape and mould my child to become the man/woman of integrity who will live a steadfast life for Jesus. Amen.



#### [Day 14] Ephesians 4:32 (NIV)

<sup>32</sup> Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Most Merciful God, give to my child a forgiving heart that will not hold grudges; a heart that is not easily hurt. Amen.

# [Day 15] Ephesians 5:1-2 (NIV)

<sup>1</sup> Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children <sup>2</sup> and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

Loving God, I pray that my child will experience your love and in turn love others as you love. Amen.

# [Day 16] Ephesians 6:1 (NIV)

<sup>1</sup>Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

Dear God, teach me to parent my child with love and grace so that he/she will be an obedient child. Amen.

# [Day 17] Matthew 6:31-33 (NIV)

<sup>31</sup> So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' <sup>32</sup> For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. <sup>33</sup> But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Father in Haven, I pray that my child will grow up placing you first and consider only on eternal things that matter in his/her life. In so doing he/she also will experience your generous providence. Amen.

### [Day 18] Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

<sup>11</sup> For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

Thank you, Awesome God, for the wonderful plans you have for my child. May he/she fulfil your purposes for him/her in your good time. Amen.

#### [Day 19] *Jeremiah 33:3 (NIV)*

<sup>3</sup> 'Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.'

Everlasting God, enable me to impress upon my child that you are an all knowing God who longs to talk and relate to us. Amen.

### [Day 20] Psalm 121:8 (NIV)

<sup>8</sup> the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.

All Powerful God, thank you for watching over and protecting my child wherever he/she may be throughout his/her life. Amen.



# [Day 21] 2 Timothy 1:7 (NIV)

<sup>7</sup> For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

Spirit of God, grant unto my child, power, love and self-discipline to live a life pleasing to you. Amen.

# [Day 22] James 4:7 (NIV)

<sup>7</sup>Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Lord Jesus, I pray that my child will learn to submit to you and be strengthened by you to resist the devil. Amen.

### [Day 23] 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (NIV)

<sup>16</sup> Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray continually, <sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Grant O Lord, to my child a joyful heart, a prayerful spirit and a thankful attitude. Amen.

### [Day 24] Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV)

<sup>5</sup> Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup> in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

Dear Lord, I pray that my child will grow up always seeking and trusting your guidance in all his/her endeavours. Amen.

#### [Day 25] *Ephesians 2:10 (NIV)*

<sup>10</sup> For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Creator Father, I pray that my child will always be secure knowing his/her identity and worth in Christ Jesus. Amen.

### [Day 26] *Psalm 42 (NIV)*

<sup>1</sup> As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God.

Lord Jesus, satisfy my child's every spiritual need; place in him/her a passion for the things that is in your heart. Amen.

# [Day 27] Philippians 4:8 (NIV)

<sup>8</sup> Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

Father God, fill the mind of my child with positive, godly and noble thoughts to counter the negative, evil and corrupt agenda of the world. Amen.



[Day 28] Philippians 2:13 (NIV)

<sup>13</sup> for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.

I give thanks to you, Most Faithful God, that what you have begun in my child, you will complete and it will be the best. Amen.

[Day 29] John 10:27-28 (NIV)

<sup>27</sup> My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

Jesus, Great Shepherd of our souls, I pray that my child will learn to recognize your voice and follow closely after you all the days of his/her life. Amen.

### [Day 30] Galatians 5:13 (NIV)

<sup>13</sup> You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

Dear God, give to my child a servant's heart, just like Jesus. Help him/her grow up desiring more to be like Jesus and less like the world around him/her. Teach him/her to be a true servant in both word and deed. Amen.

#### [Day 31] 2 Corinthians 6:14 (NIV)

<sup>14</sup> Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness?

Dear Lord, I pray that my child will not be unequally yoked in intimate relationships and desire to be with someone who is in an intimate relationship with you. I pray that my child's future life partner will love, honour and serve You. Amen
