Apart from the above thrusts, we will continue to develop in tandem our two other themes of **'Growing-in-Christ'**, through our usual Bible Reading Drive (BRD) and Devotion in Groups as well as, **'Building Community'** through getting Wesleyans to be involved in Small Groups and relational communities. For our BRD plans, this will be our last instalment of our three years' endeavour to complete reading through the whole Bible. We hope and pray that the year 2020 will see us as a Church, growing even stronger in Christ, building genuine community and impacting our world where our Lord will be glorified. **To God be the glory!**

### **BIBLE READING DRIVE 2018–2020**

- We are now in Year 3 (2020), the third and final year of Wesley Methodist Church's three-year Bible Reading Plan. If you have been following the Bible Reading Drive (BRD) 2018–2020 every day, you would have read a total of 47 Books, including Psalms and Proverbs, by the end of December 2019.
- For 2020, we will be reading the remaining 19 Books in this sequence: Job, Ecclesiastes, Song of Songs, Lamentations, Mark (during Lent), Hebrews, 1 Peter, 2 Peter, Jude, 1 Kings, 2 Kings, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, 1 Chronicle, 2 Chronicle, Daniel, Ezekiel and Revelation.
- In addition, Psalms will continue to be read daily except Fridays, while Proverbs will continue to be read every Friday. By the end of 2020, we would have read Psalms a total of five times over the three years, and Proverbs three times.
- In Year 1 (2018), we read 20 Books in the following reading sequence: 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Luke (during Lent), Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 Thessalonians, 2 Thessalonians, 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, James and Matthew.
- In Year 2 (2019), the following 25 Books (in reading sequence) were read: Acts, Romans, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John, John (during Lent), Jonah, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi, Jeremiah, Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, Isaiah.
- In both Year 1 and 2, Psalms was read daily except Fridays, while Proverbs was read every Friday.

The Bible Reading Drive (BRD) was started at Wesley Methodist Church on 1 January 2016 to inculcate the spiritual discipline of reading the Bible daily among its members. This initiative is also in line with developing in Wesleyans the "Y" of the six W.E.S.L.E.Y. attributes, which is that a disciple "yields to God's Word in life and ministry, certain of His promises and assured of future hope."

As BRD 2017 was drawing to a close, a committee was formed to explore a new Bible reading plan that will take Wesleyans to the end of 2020, which will mark the completion of the church's Directions 2020 initiatives. The Committee, comprising members from the Discipleship & Nurture Committee, Communications Committee and Small Group Ministry, decided to design a three-year reading plan in-house rather than adopt one of the many Bible reading plans available to churches. The committee feels that a self-designed reading plan would better complement and support the church's programmes and initiatives, especially its themes of Building Community in 2018 and Impacting the World in 2019 and 2020.

The Committee also decided that the daily readings would be shorter compared with BRD 2016/17. The intention is for Wesleyans to spend more time to read, reflect on, and respond to God's Word, and we pray that in so doing, we will rest in God's presence and allow Him to transform us – in what we do and how we live.

May every Wesleyan actively participate in this spiritual discipline and read Scripture daily, obey God's Word, encounter Jesus and be transformed by His Holy Spirit.



### JOIN OR FORM A BRD DEVOTION GROUP

Devotion is a spiritual discipline that enables you to receive God's Word into your life. You could do this on your own but committing to a group spurs you on and also gives you the opportunity to hear what God may be saying to you through other members in the group.

### **YOUR COMMITMENT**

1

Join or gather a group of seven to eight people who will commit to read the Bible on their own daily, and meet as a group once a week.



Commit to an initial period of six weeks and, closer to completion, revisit your commitment with other members in the group.



During the six weeks, read the Bible daily by following the BRD Reading Plan.



- Meet as a Devotion Group for one hour a week. This is what you will be doing during the 60 minutes:
- a. First 20 minutes: Read the assigned Bible passages for the day in silence and in one another's presence.
- **b.** Second 20 minutes: Write in your journal what God is saying to you through the Scriptures.
- c. Final 20 minutes: Share, as you are comfortable, what God has been saying to you in the last 40 minutes.

### WHAT DO YOU WRITE IN YOUR JOURNAL?

Use the R.O.A.D. format (see next page) to Read,
Observe, Apply and Do what God is saying to you through the Scriptures.

Read the Bible for formation, and not purely for information. In formational reading, you will be reading the Scriptures to discern and respond to what God is saying to you.

Ask yourself what is God calling you to do or to be. How may you grow in Christ? What lessons of Christlikeness are there to be learnt? What examples of Christ are there to follow? What promises of God are there to claim? And what commands are there to obey?



Write your feelings, thoughts and reflections down in your journal and then commit to put them into practice in your life. Allow God's Word to transform what you do and how you live.



### USING THE R.O.A.D. Format

As you do the readings, use this **R.O.A.D. format** to help you hear and respond to what God is saying to you through the Scriptures. Write your reflections in your journal. **READ** or listen to the Scripture readings for the day, inviting the Holy Spirit to give you understanding. It is best to read through all the prescribed Bible passages first. Then go back and read the passage/verse that you feel God wants you to focus on and which resonates with your spirit. Read that passage/verse a third time, slowly.

**OBSERVE** what the passage/verse is about. When and where did the event happen? What was the context? Who were the people involved? What was the main message the writer had for the people of that time? As you re-read that particular section, take note of what you observe in that passage. Record your observations.

**APPLY** the passage/verse to your life. What relevance has this passage/verse to your life? What are the lessons to be learned? What promises are there to claim? What examples are there to follow? What commands are there to obey? Look for all the possible applications for your life coming out of what you understand the passage is saying. Here is when you move from information to revelation.

what God has revealed to you. Choose one of the applications and commit yourself, with full dependence on God, to do the application that day. It may be to respond in worship, to act in faith on something, to fulfil the premise to the promise, to correct a behaviour, to restore a relationship, to share the revelation with someone else, to serve someone in need, etc. When you do what is revealed to you, you move from revelation to transformation. Once you have carried out what God has purposed you to do, record your experience in obeying God's revelation to you.

Be sure to develop a healthy habit of spending time daily with God.
